

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### RESERVING A TRIP

You can reserve your place by submitting this application form by fax, email, or regular mail along with a deposit of \$500. We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover Card, and personal checks mailed with application forms. You can also make reservations by phone. Contact us at (941) 929-1901.

### NOTES ON COSTS

Our trips are budgeted for a full or near capacity group. To avoid the possibility of canceling journeys due to fewer members, we may charge more for smaller groups, which is necessary to cover the fixed costs of operating the trip. Costs are based on double occupancy. If you wish a single room, you will pay a single room supplement fee. If you are willing to share accommodations, we will match you with a compatible roommate if one is available. If we cannot match you with a roommate, the single supplement will apply. Note regarding single accommodations: People requesting single accommodations may not be able to have singles in all hotels.

Journey cost is based on "land cost." You are responsible to book and pay for your air travel to and from Peru. In Peru, for your convenience, we will book your air reservations and charge you for the cost. Since air travel rates can vary, our estimated price may change.

#### Summary of Land Cost:

- Accommodations in hotels as noted in the itinerary
- Meals as indicated in the itinerary
- Services of trip leader, guides, and shamans
- Services of staff
- Ground transportation including buses, taxis, trains, and launches as indicated in the itinerary
- All necessary equipment, ceremonial items, and other support material

#### What Land Cost Does Not Include:

- International airfare
- Internal flights
- Meals specified as "on your own"
- Airport departure taxes in each departure city in Peru
- Optional tipping or gratuities to leaders or staff
- Additional hotel nights should they be needed due to airline schedule changes or other unpredictable factors
- Medical cost (doctor's fees, medications, immunizations)
- Travel insurance
- Personal expenses (liquor, laundry, gifts, etc.).

### CONCELLATION POLICY

We reserve the right to cancel any trip prior to departure for any reason including insufficient group reservations, logistical problems, and severe weather that may impede trip operations or pose a danger to our staff and travelers. If we cancel a trip due to unforeseen obstacles, you will receive your refund as promptly as possible. If you cancel for any reason, the refund is subject to the cancellation fee schedule. If you cancel, but wish to transfer to another trip at a later date, we will apply the entire amount of your payment to the new trip.

## AIR TRAVEL TO AND FROM PERU

Trip members are responsible to make their own arrangements for international air transportation to and from Peru. We will suggest flight routings and airlines. *Please review your proposed air schedule with us before purchasing your tickets.* Once flights have been booked, fax (1-941-929-1903) or email us a copy at [info@andeancodex.com](mailto:info@andeancodex.com) so that we can inform our local guide of your arrival and departure times.

Due to airline schedules, an extra overnight may be necessary at either the start or end of your trip. This is an 'on your own' expense. If this becomes necessary, we will book the extra hotel night or extra airport transfers for your convenience and charge you the cost.

Lima, Peru, is the meeting point for most of our trips, and from where you will be transferred to your hotel on Day 1. At the end of the trip you will be transferred to the airport in Lima for departure on international flights. Should it be necessary, an "on your own" expense day room will be provided for you in Lima with an evening transfer to the airport.

## JOURNEY MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

It is the responsibility of the journey member to hold a valid passport and obtain a visa if necessary. US citizens do not require a visa to enter Peru. It is your responsibility to prepare for the journey by studying the travel information and itinerary, to be in sufficient good health to undertake the journey, and to have sufficient funds to cover unforeseen costs. It is the member's responsibility to bring appropriate clothing and equipment as advised in the detailed information provided in the application packet and on the website.

## LEADERSHIP

These journeys were developed by J. E. Williams, O.M.D. (*Santiago*) in response to interest in his work and writing, and by request of the Q'ero Indians. He was adopted by a Siberian Eskimo family on St. Lawrence Island in the Bering Sea where he lived from 1967-68, and was given the name of *Yupihug*, meaning a "true human being." He is also an adopted member of the Q'ero Nation of the Peruvian Andes where he has worked since 2000. Santiago is fluent in Spanish and knowledgeable in Quechua. He is the author of *Viral Immunity*, *Prolonging Health*, *Beating the Flu*, and *The Andean Codex*.
